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For educators focused on continuity of learning, Lexia’s programs are proven to have helped improve outcomes during the pandemic, regardless of the learning environment or classroom model.

- Results from a 2021 study of 2,034 Emergent Bilinguals across 21 schools in California showed students who used Lexia English scored higher on their Overall, Oral, and Written ELPAC scores than students who did not use Lexia English.
- The largest positive difference for Lexia English users compared to non-Lexia English users was seen for the oral domain and is consistent with Lexia English’s emphasis on speaking and supporting students’ English language development through academic conversations.
- From a growth perspective, Emergent Bilingual students in a 2021 study in Arizona who used Lexia English showed greater English language proficiency growth on the overall AZELLA (Arizona English Language Assessment) than students who did not use Lexia English. Lexia English users also showed significantly greater growth in the speaking and reading domains.

When looking at federal requirements for funding, ESSER III seeks to “ensure that such interventions respond to students’ academic, social, and emotional needs and address the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on underrepresented student groups.”

Lexia English is based on proven learning science and was developed to address the need for educational equity for Emergent Bilinguals. Its asset model focuses on what students can do—their strengths, skills, talents, interests, and competencies. Learners’ backgrounds, heritage languages, and cultures are celebrated and not viewed as a deficit. The program views diversity in thought, culture, and traits as positive assets, and teachers and students alike are valued for what they bring to the classroom rather than what they may lack or need to work on.
